Hulu Medicine uses data to locate medication for patients in urgent need. 54.3% of medicines are located in less than 10 minutes, offering quick access to life-saving medication.

Because International's mission is to alleviate poverty by distributing impact products and supporting product-focused entrepreneurs. The Shoe That Grows is a shoe that expands five sizes and lasts for years. As of 2023, 438,994 pairs have been distributed in over 100 countries.

Otto Monroy & Carrie Becker | <u>LogosWorks</u> <u>Partners</u> | York, Pennsylvania

LogosWorks acquires and partners with for-profit businesses to provide rapid advancement to those in need of economic opportunity. One of their partners, the classical and Christian Logos Academy, serves over 220 students in grades K-12, two thirds of which live at or near the federal poverty line.



Susannah Farr | gold-youth | Uganda, Rwanda, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Botswana, South Africa

gold-youth's goal is to develop 10 million young African leaders with character and integrity to mobilize their generation to reach their full potential, with concrete results in social behavior change, education, and job creation. From 2018-2023 they saw a 29% increase in school performance and commitment to education, 43% increase in positive character attributes and purpose-driven interiority, and 49% increase in work readiness and employability.



John Molineaux, Briony Fickling, & Sally Bolis | <u>Love</u> <u>Justice</u> | International

Love Justice stops human trafficking, helps put traffickers in jail, and cares for orphaned and abandoned children. Over 64,000 people have been intercepted from being trafficked and over 1,500 arrests have been made from their anti-trafficking work.

Adrienne Lane | Water for Good | Central African Republic

Water for Good drills and maintains water wells in the Central African Republic. In 2023 they made 124 new water points, made 3,628 maintenance visits, and filled 5,167,900 jerry cans with water from tapstands.
